Heard Mr. J. Roy, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner. Also heard Mr. B .S. Sinha, learned Additional Public Prosecutor for the State respondent.

The petitioners namely, Rahima Begum, Mubarak Ali, NurulHaque and MoinulHaque have prayed for pre-arrest bail in respect of Nagaon PS Case No. 1486/2013 under Section 498(A) of IPC.

The learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in the aforementioned case the informant has made false and concocted allegations against the petitioners. The learned counsel for the petitioners has also submitted that the petitioners had never demanded dowry from the informant namely, Liza Hazarika, wife of Mustaque Ahmed.

I have gone through the case diary having regard to the arguments advanced by learned counsel for the parties. On making such an exercise, I am of the opinion that the prayer for pre-arrest bail needs to be accepted in respect of the petitioners.

Accordingly, it is provided that in the event of arrest of the accused petitioner in connection with aforementioned case, the arresting authority would release them on bail on their furnishing bail bond of Rs.15,000/- each to the satisfaction of the arresting authority.

They are directed not to interfere with the investigation of the case aforementioned.

In view of the above, the case is disposed of.
