1. The instant appeal under Clause 12 of the Letters Patent is directed against the judgment and order dated 10.12.2013 passed by a learned Single Judge of this Court dismissing the writ petition filed by the writ petitioner-appellant, upholding the order of his transfer. It is appropriate to mention that the order of transfer dated 04.12.2013 has posted the writ petitioner-appellant from the field post to the office of Health Officer. The fact remains that the petitioner-appellant has been working in Jammu and continue to work in the same city. The only ground urged against the order of transfer before us is that the order suffers from malafide of respondent No.5-Rinku Gill. According to the petitioner-appellant, respondent No.5 is his uncle and is working on the post of Sanitary Supervisor. On the query raised

by the Court that how he can influence his transfer no

satisfactory answer could be given. As per the rules, the

transfer can be ordered either by the Joint Commissioner or

Commissioner. The appellant vide order dated 04.12.2013 has

been transferred by the Commissioner and a Sanitary

Supervisor like respondent No.5 can have no say in the matter.

The allegation of malafide is, therefore, imaginary and does not

call for any probe.

2. For the reasons aforementioned, this appeal fails and

same is dismissed along with connected application.
