2/31.01.2013: Anticipatory bail application filed by petitioner Binod Chouhan is moved by Sri P.P.N. Roy, Sr. Advocate and opposed by Sri Awanikant Prasad, learned Additional P.P.

It is alleged that some railway property recovered from the godown of Binod Chouhan situated at Bankuana, Deoghar. However, it is submitted that petitioner let that godown to one Raju Jha @ Ashok Jha by entering into an agreement on 21.5.2012. Thus, it is clear that at the time of raid petitioner was not in the possession of premises in question.

Learned Additional P.P. after going through Annexure-2 of the instant application, has not disputed the aforesaid submission.

Considering the aforesaid fact and circumstance I allow this application and direct the petitioner to surrender in the court below by 07.02.2013 and in that event the court below is directed to enlarge the petitioner, above named, on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/-(Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Railway Judicial Magistrate, Madhupur in connection with R.P.F. Post Case No. 08 of 2012 ,subject to the condition as laid down under section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
