It reveals from the fardbeyan that the deceased had gone to his in-laws house situated at village Basmati. His wife Vishakha was having illicit relation with accused Sukumar Mandal, therefore, he was disturbed due to that illicit relation. Before death the deceased had made a call to the informant and informed that there is every chance that he would be murdered by his wife and in-laws. Thereafter mobile of the deceased got switched off. The informant rushed to village Basmati where he found his son dead in the courtyard of the house. It was informed that the deceased himself consumed poison.

It is submitted that one of the accused Sukumar Mandal has been granted bail by this Court vide B.A. No.3950 of 2013. Petitioners are wife and parents-in-law of the deceased. Cause of death till the date could not be ascertained. Only suspicion has been raised.

Learned counsel appearing for the State opposed the prayer for bail.

Considering facts and circumstances, above named petitioners are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Court of learned Addl. Chief Judicial Magistrate, Pakur in connection with Maheshpur P.S. Case No.52 of 2013 corresponding to G.R. Case No.249 of 2013.
