03/ 30.09.2013 It is submitted on behalf of the petitioner in the present writ application that the respondents have taken a decision to pay the balance 40% of Gratuity and Leave Encashment amount to such persons, as per affidavit filed in WPS No. 6381/12 and other analogous cases. It is further submitted that in other batch of writ petitions led by WPS No. 6380/12 also, similar affidavit has been filed. In such circumstances, there is no reason as to why such payments should not be made to the present petitioner.

2. In such circumstances, it therefore appears that in similar circumstances, payments have been made in respect of other petitioners. Accordingly, petitioner may prefer representation before the Respondent no. 2 - The Managing Director, Ranchi Central Cooperative Bank Ltd. Ranchi for redressal of his aforesaid grievances, together with all supporting facts and documents, within a period of two weeks. On receipt of such representations, the Respondent No. 2 shall consider the same in accordance with law and take a decision in the matter of payment of balance 40% of Leave Encashment and Gratuity amount, within a period of four weeks thereafter, if there are no other legal impediment and the case of the present petitioner stands on similar footing to that of other similarly situated petitioners of WPS No. 6381/12 and analogous writ petitions.

Writ petition stands disposed of accordingly.
