Petitioner is an accused in this case registered under Sections 25(1-b)A/26/35 of the Arms Act.

Counsel appearing for the petitioner has submitted that the allegation against the petitioner in the F.I.R. is that one live cartridge has been recovered from the possession of the petitioner. It is also submitted that the petitioner is in custody since 16<sup>th</sup> February, 2013 i.e. more than four months.

Counsel appearing for the State has opposed but not disputed the aforesaid contentions made by the counsel appearing for the petitioner.

Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the period of custody, the petitioner, above named, is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Rs. Ten thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Dumka in connection with Dumka (Muffasil) P.S. Case No. 21 of 2013 corresponding to G.R. No. 208 of 2013 subject to the condition that one the bailors will be local resident having immovable property within the jurisdiction of district concerned.
