The petitioner is accused in a case registered under Section 7 of the E.C. Act and section 3 of L.P.G. Regulation of Supply Act, Order, 2000.

It reveals that two gas cylinder of Indane company and one of H.P. Company of 5 k.g. have been recovered from the shop of this petitioner but he succeeded to flee away.

It is submitted that one of the co-accused Rajesh Kumar has been granted anticipatory bail by this Court vide A.B.A. No.2304 of 2012 dated 11.09.2012. The gas cylinder of 5 k.g. is neither domestic nor commercial and no such gas cylinder is being supplied to persons belonging to B.P.L.

Learned counsel appearing for the State has opposed the prayer for bail.

Since the other co-accused Rajesh Kumar, having more or less similar allegation, has been granted anticipatory bail by this Court, above named petitioner is directed to surrender before the Court below within a period of three weeks from today and on such surrender he is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Court of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Dumka in connection with Dumka (T) P.S. Case No.196 of 2010 corresponding to G.R. Case No.1458 of 2010.
