It is alleged in the F.I.R. that the petitioner, who was an employee of informant, hatched out a conspiracy with other accused persons and after that another employee, who had collected Rs.1 lac for the informant, was looted away on the way from Chaibasa railway station to Amla Tola.

It is submitted that another co-accused Naresh Das against whom allegation is similar, has been granted bail by another Bench of this Court vide B.A. No.2735 of 2013.

Learned counsel appearing for the State opposed the prayer for bail.

Since other co-accused having similar allegation is enjoying the privilege of bail, above named petitioner is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the Court of learned C.J.M. at Chaibasa in connection with Sadar P.S. Case No.63 of 2012 corresponding to G.R. Case No.455 of 2012.
