28.02.2013 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned counsel for the State.

Petitioner is accused in connection with Jagannathpur PS case No. 39 of 2012 pending in the court of learned ACJM, Chaibasa.

It reveals that a dacoity was committed in the house of the informant and the dacoits have looted away mobile sets, cash etc. from the house. During investigation, complicity of the petitioner came in light and he has been remanded to judicial custody. This petitioner was also identified by the informant in the test identification parade.

It is submitted that name of this petitioner has come in the confessional statement of co-accused. Nothing incriminating has been recovered from his possession. He is in custody since 31.7.2012.

Learned counsel for the State has opposed the prayer.

Since the petitioner has been identified in the test identification parade by the informant, I do not feel inclined to grant him bail at this stage. Accordingly, prayer for bail is rejected. However, petitioner may renew his prayer for bail after six months, if trial is not concluded.
