appearing for the State.

The petitioners are in custody since 17.12.2012, in connection with Namkum P. S. Case No. 276 of 2012, corresponding to G.R. No. 6259 of 2012, S.T.No. 250 of 2013, registered under Sections 302 and 34 of Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that from perusal of F.I.R. itself indicates that though all the four accused persons including these petitioners have been named in the F.I.R., but the informant has herself named the other co-accused person, Deva Munda, as having responsible for inflicting repeated injuries on the deceased by a 'Kudal' which led to his death. It is further submitted that the allegation against these petitioners are not of fatal assault as per the F.I.R. itself

Learned A.P.P. appearing on behalf of the State, however, opposes the prayer for bail.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, the above-named petitioners are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs. 10,000/- (Ten Thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Sri Manish, Judicial Magistrate, Ranchi, in connection with Namkum P. S. Case No. 276 of 2012, corresponding to G. R. No. 6259 of 2012, S.T. No. 250 of 2013.
