31.07.2013 Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned counsel for the State.

This is an application for anticipatory bail filed by the petitioner in connection with Chandrapura PS case No. 46 of 2013 pending in the court of learned SDJM Bermo at Tenughat. Indian Penal Code.

It reveals that the petitioner and other accused were indulged in illegal mining and illegal trade of coal. They had stored coal at a place in order to despatch the same to different destination through trucks. When the police party raided the place, a truck was also found partly loaded, but the accused persons smelling police, fled away from the place. The petitioner was identified while he was fleeing away.

It is submitted that the petitioner has no concern either with the place where coal was stored, or the truck involved in connection with this case. Petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case.

Learned counsel for the State has opposed the prayer and submitted that petitioner has good criminal history and he is involved in as many as six cases of similar nature, which is apparent from para 40 of the case diary.

Considering above aspects of the matter, I do not feel inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner. Accordingly, prayer is rejected and this application is dismissed.
