Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner while referring to page no. 09 of the paper-book has submitted that the petitioner has been apprehending his arrest in connection with C.P. Case No. 2414 of 2012, registered under Section 498-A of the I.P.C. read with Section 3/4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that though the marriage was solemnized on 11.11.2011, a complaint case was lodged only on 17.10.2012. He further submits that the petitioner is ready to keep his wife with full honour and dignity. He has further submitted that the petitioner has filed an application under Section 281 of Muslim Law. He has further submitted that the old and ailing parents of the petitioner have also been roped in the present case.

Learned counsel appearing for the State has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

In the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the

petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest, shall be released on bail on furnishing a personal bail bond of Rs.10,000./- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the arresting officer or on furnishing a bail bond of Rs.10,000./-(Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of Miss. Richa Srivastava, learned Judicial Magistrate, Dhanbad or her successor in connection with C.P. Case No. 2414 of 2012, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
