**02/31.08.2013:** The petitioner is an accused in the case registered under Sections 395 and 397 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case; the first information report is lodged against unknown person; nothing incriminating has been recovered from the petitioner's possession; he has been made accused on the basis of the confessional statement of co-accused; said co-accused has been granted bail by this Court in B.A. No.8100 of 2012; the petitioner is in custody since March, 2012 but till date he has not been put on test identification parade; he is a local permanent resident; there is no chance of his absconding.

Learned A.P.P. opposed the petitioner's prayer for bail, but has not disputed the said contentions.

Regard being had to the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner, above-named, is directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (rupees ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount, each, to the satisfaction of learned Judicial Commissioner-XIII, Ranchi in connection with S.T. No.649 of 2012, arising out of Lapung P.S. Case No.59 of 2011, corresponding to G.R. no.5168 of 2011.
