Petitioner has been made accused for the offence under Sections 363/365/34 of the Indian Penal Code, in connection with Mandu (Kuju) P.S. Case No.56 of 2011, corresponding to G.R. No.740 of 2011.

There being direct allegation against the petitioner to kidnapped the minor daughter of the informant, who is still traceless, the bail application of this petitioner was earlier rejected on merits by order dated 1.10.2012 in B.A. No. 6161 of 2012.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has renewed the prayer for bail.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, I am not inclined to release the petitioner Nisha Kullu on bail. Accordingly, prayer for bail stands dismissed.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that all the material witnesses have been examined in this case and only the I.O. has remained to be examined.

The submission of the learned counsel for the petitioner, if true, the Trial Court shall take all the effective steps for examination of the I.O. at early date and shall dispose of the case expeditiously.
