**02 /31.08.2013.** Heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and learned counsel for the State.

The petitioners are accused in a case instituted under Sections 392 and 397 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioners submits that since the informant was robbed of his motorcycle by some unknown miscreants, a case was registered under Sections 395 and 397 of the Indian Penal Code. Subsequently, when a motorcycle is said to have been recovered from the house of this petitioner, a case was lodged under Section 414 IPC in which the petitioner was taken into custody. The Police got the petitioner remanded in the case registered under Sections 392, 397 of the Indian Penal Code as it is said that said Motorcycle was subject matter of this case though there has been absolutely no evidence to show that the petitioner was the person who committed offence under Sections 392, 397 of the Indian Penal Code and, therefore, the petitioner under the circumstances, as stated above, deserves to be admitted on bail.

Regard being had to the facts and circumstances of the case, the above-named petitioners are directed to be released on bail on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (ten thousand) each with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the learned S.D.J.M., Khunti, in connection with Arki P.S. Case No.34 of 2011, corresponding to G.R. No.378 of 2011.
