02/31.10.2013 Heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and learned counsel appearing for the State.

Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner while referring to page no. 09 of the paper-book has submitted that the petitioner has been apprehending his arrest in connection with Sadar P.S. Case No. 456 of 2013, corresponding to G.R. No. 2277 of 2013 registered under Sections 341, 323, 354, 504/34 of the Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has further submitted that earlier the marriage of the petitioner was settled in the family of the informant however, it could not be solemnized and therefore, out of grudge, this false case has been registered against the petitioner and his father. He has further submitted that this fact finds corroboration from the observation in the impugned order itself wherein it has been recorded in paragraph nos. 10 & 11 the witnesses have supported the defence of the petitioner. He has further submitted that all the offences are bailable except, offence under Section 354 of the I.P.C.

Learned counsel appearing for the State has opposed the prayer for anticipatory bail.

In the aforesaid facts and circumstances, the petitioner, above named, in the event of his arrest, shall be released on bail on furnishing a personal bail bond of Rs.10,000./- (Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of the arresting officer or on furnishing a bail bond of Rs.10,000./-(Ten thousand) with two sureties of the like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Hazaribag in connection with Sadar P.S. Case No. 456 of 2013, corresponding to G.R. No. 2277 of 2013, subject to the condition as laid down under Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
