Petitioner has been made accused for the offence under Sections 302/307/328/120B/34 of the Indian Penal Code, in connection with Godda (T) P.S. Case No.35 of 2005, corresponding to G.R. No.136 of 2005.

The case relates to murder of the husband and the son of the informant by poisoning and in the FIR, there is suspicion and allegation against other co-accused persons. It is only shown in the FIR that earlier the informant was running a school along with the petitioner and they had separated.

It appears that the petitioner was granted anticipatory bail by this Court by order dated 22.9.2005 in A.B.A. No.896 of 2005 and it was directed that the anticipatory bail shall remain in force for six months and thereafter petitioner shall be at liberty to pray for regular bail. Subsequently the petitioner prayed for regular bail, which was rejected.

In the facts and circumstances of the case, I am inclined to release the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, the petitioner Ashok Kumar Yadav @ Ashok Kr. Yadav is directed to be released on bail, on furnishing bail bond of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) with two sureties of like amount each to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Godda, in connection with Godda (T) P.S. Case No.35 of 2005, corresponding to G.R. No.136 of 2006.
