ORDER (OPEN COURT)

(Passed on 28<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2013)

1. Challenge in this petition is to the award dated 14.1.2000 whereby the Labour Court directed the petitioner to reinstate the respondent in service with full back-wages.
2. The matter was listed for hearing on 08.04.2002 and on the request of learned State counsel, the matter was adjourned. Thereafter, the matter was again listed on 24.06.2008. On 22.07.2008, the State/petitioner was granted two weeks time to obtain instructions with regard to compliance of provisions of Section 17-B of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947. Notices were issued to the respondent on 12.08.2008. After issuance of the notice, the State/petitioner has not taken any steps to get the matter listed.
3. At this stage, when the impugned order was passed 12 years back and the same must have been complied with by the State/petitioner, as no interim order was passed in favour of the petitioner and a right in favour of the respondent has already been settled. Thus, no useful purpose would be served at this stage, particularly in the facts of the case where the order is of reinstatement with back wages, which was passed on 15.11.2000.
4. Accordingly, the petition is dismissed. No order as to costs.
