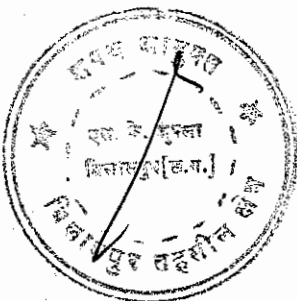

	<p><u>SB : Hon'ble Shri Manindra Mohan Shrivastava, J.</u> <u>28-06-2013</u></p> <p>Shri Samir Singh, counsel for the petitioner/s.</p> <p>Shri Vivek Shrivastava, counsel for respondents on advance copy.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that aggrieved by order of termination, the petitioner has preferred representation to respondent No.3 on 28/01/13.</p> <p>The pleadings and documents show that the petitioner was appointed on provisional basis vide order dated 04/08/11 and thereafter, his services have been terminated vide impugned order dated 07/12/12 (Annexure P/2), purporting to be under the terms of provisional appointment. The petitioner preferred representation which has remained pending before respondent No.3.</p> <p>Learned counsel for the respondent submits that if any such representation is pending, the same shall be considered and decided in accordance with law.</p> <p>In view of the submission of learned counsel for the parties, this petition is disposed off with a direction to respondent No.3 to decide petitioner's claim / representation against the order of termination as early as possible.</p>
