





JUDGEMENT (28th June, 2013)

1. This is a writ appeal against the order of the single judge dated 01.05.2013 dismissing the Writ Petition(S)-1281 of 2013 filed by the Appellants.

THE FACTS

- 2. The Appellants filed the aforesaid writ petition with the following allegations:
 - The Appellants were engaged by the Municipal Council, Dongargarh, district Rajnandgaon (the Council) on daily-wages as class-IV employees, on different dates;
 - There are 49 vacancies, however, the Council had advertised only seven posts on 25.03.2013. In this advertisement there is a restriction in the age;
 - The Appellants have been for a long period in the Council and as
 such have become overage and relaxation should be granted.
- 3. The writ petition was dismissed so far as the question of age relaxation was concerned. But, it was disposed of with a direction to the Council to advertise all vacant posts, if there is any. Hence, the present writ appeal.



THE DECISION

- 4. We have heard counsel for the parties. There is no objection in condoning the delay in filing the appeal. The application IA-1 is allowed and the delay in filing the appeal is condoned. It is heard for admission.
- 5. It is not disputed between the parties that under Rule 16 of Chhattisgarh Municipal Corporation (Appointment and Conditions of Service of Officers and Servants), Rules 2007 (the Rules) relaxation in age can be granted with the previous sanction of the State Government.
- 6. Considering the aforesaid aspect, it would be appropriate that the Appellants may file representations before the Municipal Council, Dongargarh, through its Chief Municipal Officer, Dongargarh, district Rajnandgaon (Respondent-2). In case such representations are filed, they may be decided by Respondent-2 in accordance with law by a speaking order, if possible, within three months from the date of receipt of the representations. The Appellants will file certified copy of this order; other necessary documents and duly stamped self-addressed envelope along with their representations. Respondent-2 after taking decision will communicate the same to the Appellants.

7. With the aforesaid observations, the writ appeal is disposed of.
