Advocate for the State.</p> <p>While allowing bail application of the applicant vide order dated 04/07/2013 in M.Cr.C. No. 2660/2013 this Court directed the applicant to deposit a sum of Rs.1.25 Lakhs in the form of a term deposit receipt in the name of the objector Surendra Singh Kushwaha to be deposited before the Trial Court for the entire period during which the trial remains pending.</p> <p>This application for modification has been submitted on the ground that because of Reserve Bank of India guidelines the concerned Bank where the applicant approached for purchasing a demand draft is not issuing the draft in the absence of credential of the complainant in whose favour the draft is to be purchased.</p> <p>In view of above, the order dated 04/07/2013 in M.Cr.C. No. 2660/2013 is modified to the extent that the draft of Rs.1.25 Lakhs shall be drawn in the name of Judicial Magistrate First Class, Rajnandgaon.</p> <p>The other condition imposed in the bail order shall remain as it is.</p> <p>Accordingly, Cr.M.P. stands disposed of.</p>	<p>Sd/- Prashant Kumar Mishra Judge</p>
