While allowing bail application of the applicant vide order dated 04/07/2013 in M.Cr.C. No. 2660 2013 this Court directed the applicant to deposit a sum of Rs.1.25 Lakhs in the form of a term deposit receipt in the name of the objector Surendra Singh Kushwaha to be deposited before the Trial Court for the entire period during which the trial remains pending.

This application for modification has been submitted on the ground that because of Reserve Bank of India guidelines the concerned Bank where the applicant approached for purchasing a demand draft is not issuing the draft in the absence of credential of the complainant in whose favour the draft is to be purchased.

In view of above, the order dated 04/07/2013 in M.Cr.C. No. 2660/2013 is modified to the extent that the draft of Rs.1.25 Lakhs shall be drawn in the name of Judic al Magistrate First Class, Rajnandgaon.

The other condition imposed in the bail order shall remain as it is.

Accordingly, Cr.M.P. stands disposed of.
