ORAL ORDER (20/12/2013)

Petitioners have preferred this writ petition seeking direction to the respondents to consider their representation for their reappointment on any suitable post on the ground that the petitioners have worked as Maleriya Swaichchhik Sampark Karyakarta from July, 1999 to August 2003, however, their services were discontinued on the ground that the National Maleriya Eradication Scheme has been closed.

- 2. From the argument raised by learned counsel for the petitioners and the documents annexed it would appear that petitioners worked as Link Workers on contract basis under the above stated Scheme, however, after the said project funded by World Bank came to an end they have been discontinued.
- 3. In the matter of *Principal, Mehar Chand Polytechnic and another Vs. Anu Lamba and Others*<sup>1</sup> it is settled law that any contract appointee or adhoc appointee engaged in connection with a scheme can be removed on closure of scheme and in such event the appointee has no right to continue because his appointment is co-terminus with the scheme.
- 4. In view of the settle legal position, no case for interference in this writ petition is made out.
- 5. Accordingly, the writ petition is dismissed, however, dismissal of the petition shall not come in the way of the respondents, if they desire to reemploy the petitioners in any other project/Scheme under the Government policy.
