## M. Cr. C. No. 3210/2013 Amar Singh Vs. State of MP

This is first application filed by the applicant under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail, who is apprehending his arrest in connection with Crime No.94/2013 registered at Police Station Dehat, District Bhind for the offence punishable under Sections 294, 307 read with Section 34 of IPC.

Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant is a Government employee working in PWD Department as Timekeeper. He apprehends his arrest in the aforesaid offence. It is also submitted that the applicant has falsely been implicated in the case. He has not committed any offence. The injury which has been caused to the complainant is by hard and blunt object, while as per allegation the injury which has been caused by firearm is at the wheel of the tractor. It is, therefore, submitted that the application filed by the applicant may be allowed and the anticipatory bail be granted.

Learned Public Prosecutor for the respondent-State as well as learned counsel for the complainant submits that the application filed by the applicant be dismissed as no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out. It is also submitted that there is a bony injury found on the person of the complainant and one of the ribs was also fractured. Learned counsel for the complainant submits that earlier, the applicant committed offences twice for which, FIR was also registered against him.

After taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case, this application is disposed of with a short direction that the applicant shall surrender before the Court below within two weeks from today and shall apply for regular bail. If such application is filed by the applicant, then the Court below shall consider the same, keeping in view the fact that the applicant is a Government employee with further fact that previous complaints were also lodged against the applicant.

With the aforesaid observation, this application stands disposed of.
