With the consent of the parties, the bail application is finally heard.

Applicants apprehend arrest in connection with offence punishable u/Ss. 498-A and 323 of IPC registered as Crime No.359/2013 at Police Station Dabra, District Gwalior.

Learned Public Prosecutor for the State opposed the application and prayed for its rejection by contending that on the basis of the allegations and the material available on record, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Considering the allegation of dowry demand related cruelty made against the applicants where the marriage had taken place in the year 2003 and arrest in offences of this nature may diminish possibility of settlement in future and that applicant no.2 is maternal uncle of the complainant and applicant no.1 is the son of applicant no.2, this Court is inclined to extend the benefit of anticipatory bail to the applicants.

Accordingly, without expressing opinion on merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to allow this application in the following terms.

It is hereby directed that in the event of arrest, the applicants shall be released on bail on furnishing a personal bond of Rs.50,000/-(Rupees Fifty Thousand only) with one solvent surety of the like amount, in each case, to the satisfaction of Arresting Authority.

This order will remain operative subject to compliance of the following conditions by the applicants:-

- 1. The applicants will comply with all the terms and conditions of the bond executed by them;
- 2. The applicants will cooperate in the investigation/trial, as

the case may be;

- The applicants will not indulge themselves in extending inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him/her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to the Police Officer, as the case may be;
- 4. The applicants shall not commit an offence similar to the offence of which they are accused;
- 5. The applicants will not seek unnecessary adjournments during the trial; and
- 6. The applicants will not leave India without previous permission of the trial Court/Investigating Officer, as the case may be.

A copy of this order be sent to the Police Station concerned for compliance.
