Learned counsel for petitioner submits that he wants to withdraw this petition and intends to pursue his representation which is already preferred before respondent No. 1, this prayer was objected by Smt. Patankar submits that such permission be not granted to the petitioner because similar petitions have already been dismissed by this court.

However, in the opinion of this court the petitioner is simply praying for withdrawal of this petition with liberty to pursue his representation before respondent No. 1, prayer is reasonable. Accordingly, this petition is permitted to be withdrawn with liberty to pursue departmental representation. It is observed that if any adverse order is passed by the said order, petitioner will be at liberty to file appropriate proceedings against the said order before the appropriate forum.
