By this application under Section 151 of the Civil Procedure Code, Counsel for the applicant has submitted that the mistake had occurred in the cause title of the petitioner's petition bearing No.9677/2013(s). Counsel submitted that the name of the respondent No.4 to be modified as the Collector, District Dewas in place of Collector District Rajgarh, which has been mistakenly typed in the cause title of the Writ Petition. Counsel submitted that the applicant was being deprived of the benefit of the order passed by this Court on 16/8/2013. Hence, Counsel prayed that the applicant be permitted to to correct the cause title of the Writ Petition.

Counsel for the respondent/State, on the other hand, has not opposed the prayer of the Counsel for the applicant and since the error is apparent on the face of the record.

On considering the above submissions, I find that the application needs to be allowed and it is hereby allowed. Counsel for the applicant is directed to amend the cause title of the Writ Petition and the Registry is directed to hand over the copy of the order dated 16/8/2013 along with the amended cause title on payment of process fees.
