**Heard.**

This is an application under Section 438 of Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail.

Applicant apprehends his arrest in connection with Crime No. 243/2012 registered at Police Station, Laur District Rewa for offence punishable under Section 379 of IPC.

Learned counsel for the applicant submitted that due to business rivalry the applicant has been falsely implicated in the case. He has no criminal past. The applicant is a reputed person of the society and in the event of arrest, his reputation would be tarnished, therefore, he prays for grant of anticipatory bail to the applicant.

Learned counsel for the State has objected the prayer for grant of anticipatory bail to the applicant.

I have perused the case diary. From perusal of case diary, it reveals that there is direct evidence against the applicant that he was involved in taking away the GI Pipe and same has been seized from the possession of one *Kabadi*. In this circumstances, it is a case wherein custodial interrogation is necessary, therefore, no case is made out for grant of anticipatory bail.

The petition is dismissed.
