Heard on IA No. 7228/2013, an application for urgent hearing.

Considering the averment, application is allowed.

This is an application under Section 439 of Cr.P.C.

The applicant is in custody since 12.2.2013 in connection with Crime No. 14/2013 registered at Police Station Rajendragram, District Anuppur for offence punishable under Sections 409, 420, 465, 471 and 120-B of IPC.

Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has been falsely implicated in this case. As per prosecution, it is alleged against the applicant that at the relevant time i.e. June 2010 to April 2012 he was Data Entry Operator in the District Education Centre. It is further alleged that he was involved in conspiracy of misappropriation of the amount. Learned counsel for the applicant further submits that co-accused Shashi Kant Pandit has already been released on bail by this Court vide order dated 21.3.2013 passed in M.Cr.C. No. 2588/2013. Charge sheet has already been filed and trial would take considerable time for its conclusion, therefore, prays for grant of bail to applicant.

Learned counsel for the State opposes the prayer.

On due consideration of the contentions raised by the counsel for the parties along with facts and circumstances of the case, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, I am of the view that it is a fit case for grant of bail to

the applicant. The application is allowed.

It is directed that applicant shall be released on bail on his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of **Rs. 30,000/- (Rupees thirty thousand)** with a solvent surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the Committal Court/Trial Court concerned, for his appearance before the said Court and on all such other dates as given in this regard by the said Court during trial.
