Vide order dated 21.4.2010 it was directed that necessary steps be taken for the service of notice to the respondent no.2 and if steps are not taken within seven days then the revision shall stand dismissed without further reference to the Bench.

It is highly objectionable that the concerned D.A did not comply the order dated 21.4.2010.

Learned counsel for the applicants is not appearing since April 2010 and therefore, it appears that he does not want to prosecute the present revision.

Consequently, the present revision filed by the applicants **Naresh Gupta** and **Raj Kumar Pandey** against the order dated 28.1.2010 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge and Special Judge, Shahdol in ST. No.44/2009 is hereby dismissed in want of prosecution.

Copy of the order be sent to the trial Court with the information that the stay order granted in the case is hereby vacated and the trial Court may proceed with the case.
