2. On 19.3.2013, the respective counsels had submitted that they would explore the possibility of amicable settlement. Today, the respondent is handing over the pay orders to the tune of Rs.42,000/- by two different pay orders, one is to the tune of Rs.35,000/- and another pay order is to the tune of Rs.7,000/-. The Counsel for the Municipal Corporation has fairly conceded to the request of the respondent to settle the dispute. Hence, the matter is amicably settled between the parties.

3. Hence, the Complaint bearing No.3669 of 2005 which was dismissed for want of prosecution by the Judicial Magistrate, First Class, Thane vide order dated 19.7.2010 is hereby quashed in view of the amicable settlement between the parties.
