- . Heard Mr.G.K.Maurye, learned counsel for the applicants and Dr. Jayshree Kurup, learned counsel for the respondent state.
- 2. This is an application for extension of time for filing a private paper book as also restoring the F.A.No.1804 of 2011 after condoning the delay of 1 year and 58 days in filing the application.

- 3. By order dated 15-07-2011, the appeal was admitted and printing was dispensed with. The appellant was directed to file requisite number of copies of private paper-books including the copies for the respondent/s within a period one year from the date of order. It was made clear that if the compliance was not made within stipulated time, the appeal would stand dismissed for want of prosecution without further reference to the Court.
- 4. Mr.Maurye assures that he will file a private paper book and serve a copy on the other side within 8 weeks from today.
- 5. In view thereof, the Civil Application is allowed in terms of prayer clauses (a), (b) and (c) with no order as to costs. Time originally fixed in the order dated 15-07-2011 for filing a private paper book and serving a copy on the other side is extended up to and inclusive of eight weeks from today. It is made clear that in case, within a period of eight weeks from

today, if a private paper book is not filed and a copy is not served on the other side, the appeal would stand dismissed for want of prosecution without further reference to the Court.
