2. By order dated 26-07-2011 the First
Appeal was admitted and printing was dispensed
with. The appellant was directed to file
requisite number of copies of private paper-
books including the copies for the
respondent/s within one year from the date of

the order. It was made clear that if the appellant within stipulated time does not file private paper books, the appeal would stand dismissed for want of prosecution without further reference to the Court.

3. Mr. Santosh Suraj states that private paper book is ready and within one week from today he will serve a copy on the other side and file it in the office.

4. In view of the assurance, time originally fixed in the order dated 26-07-2011 is extended up to and inclusive 06-12-2013. It is made clear that if the private paper book is not filed and copy thereof is not served on the other side within one week from today, the order dated 26-07-2011 dismissing the appeal for non-compliance of filing private paper books shall stand revive. The Civil Application is disposed of accordingly.
