The applicant did not give any FIR number which according to him was reported at MRA Marg Police Station, Mumbai, and Navghar Police Station, Bhayander, District Thane. Letter dated 18.10.2013 which applicant claims that he received from Navghar Police Station only indicates that some enquiry is pending with Navghar Police Station.

Learned APP rightly objected grant of anticipatory bail on the ground that blanket order cannot be passed as the accusation has to be in respect of non bailable offences and applicant must mention Crime Report number or FIR number in respect of which apprehension

is entertained by the applicant regarding his possible arrest for non-bailable offences. Furthermore, applicant came directly before the High Court without going to Sessions court concerned. Hence anticipatory bail is rejected.
