ORDER

In this writ petition the petitioner has prayed for a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the order dated 14.06.2013 in O.S. No. 359/2013 dismissing I.A. No. 13 filed under Section 151 CPC invoking Section 340 and 195 of Cr.P.C.

2. The respondents filed O.S. No. 359/2003 against the petitioner for a decree of permanent injunction restraining him from putting up illegal and unauthorised construction on Z schedule property and not to encroach upon Y schedule property and for mandatory injunction to remove the encroachment on X and Y schedule properties. During the pendency of the proceedings petitioner filed an application I.A. No. 13 under Section 151 CPC to lodge a complaint against plaintiffs under Section 340 and 195 Cr.P.C. for having forged the document in the form of power of

attorney and produced the same before the Hon'ble Court. Under the impugned order the Trial Court dismissed the application filed by the petitioner. Hence, this writ petition.

3. In view of the law declared by this Court in the case of Prabhakar Reddy K.C. Vs. State by Ashok Nagara Police Station and another, ILR 2012 Kar. 5129, the application filed by the petitioner is rightly dismissed by the Trial Court. However it is always open for the petitioner to work out his remedy in accordance with law before appropriate forum. Accordingly, the writ petition is hereby dismissed.
