ORDER

This contempt petition by the petitioner in W.P.No.38401/2012 (S-PRO) is complaining that the directions contained in the order dated 4.10.2012 particularly, for considering the representation of the petitioner for extending certain benefits, which he is entitled to based on his past service in a private institution, which has not been considered and disposed of by the accused person. Complainant has also produced Annexure C dated 22.1.2013 issued by the University apprising the complainant that his representation is under consideration and the matter is placed before the Syndicate. Having regard to the fact that an institutional decision is to be taken by the University and the time stipulations in an order of

this nature being not statutory but only to impress upon the respondents, we find no occasion to exercise contempt jurisdiction at this stage. Contempt petition is dismissed.
