This WPHC coming on for preliminary hearing this day, **Mohan M.Shantanagoudar. J**, made the following:-

ORDER

A telegram is received by the office of the Hon'ble Chief Justice intimating Hon'ble the Chief Justice that eight persons are illegally detained by one Sri Gaffar and his henchmen. The said telegram is treated as suo motu Writ Petition (Habeas Corpus).

2. The learned Government Advocate, on instructions, submits that eight persons named in the

affidavit are not in illegal detention of the said Gaffar and that they actually had business transactions with Gaffar. The statements of eight persons who are stated to be in illegal custody are recorded and the same do not reveal that they are in illegal detention of anybody muchless, Gaffar.

- 3. To the said effect, the Sub-Inspector of Police, Humnabad P.S. has filed the affidavit. The affidavit is taken on record.
- 4. Since this Court is convinced that eight persons named in the telegram are not in illegal custody, the petition stands dismissed.
