This CrI.p is filed u/s.438 of Cr.P.C praying to direct the respondent police to enlarge the petitioner on bail in the event of his arrest on the accusation of the aforesaid offences

punishable under Sec. 143, 147, 323, 109, 386, 149, 342, 364(A) IPC in Cr.No.46/2013 on the file of respondent – police.

This criminal petition is coming on for orders this day, the court made the following:-

**ORDER**

Petitioner is accused No.5 in Crime No. 46/2013 for the offences punishable under Sections 143, 147, 323, 109, 386, and 149 IPC. The matter is under investigation.

2. In the complaint, there is no reference to the name of the petitioner. However, the complaint reveals that it was a property dispute between accused No.1 and the complainant. In the circumstances, I am of the considered opinion that the petitioner is to be enlarged on bail.

Accordingly, the following:

**ORDER**

The petition is hereby allowed and petitioner is to be enlarged on bail subject to the following conditions:

- (i) In the event of respondent-police arresting the petitioner, he shall be enlarged on bail on

executing a personal bond for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five thousand only) each with a solvent surety to the satisfaction of the Respondent-police authorities.

- (i) Whenever, the petitioner is called upon to present before the I.O. he shall do so.
- (ii) The petitioner shall co-operate with the I.O for completion of investigation and in no manner shall tamper with the prosecution witnesses.

Violation of any one of the conditions above will result in cancellation of bail order. Ordered accordingly.
