This Criminal Petition is filed under Section 439 of Cr.P.C by the Advocate for the petitioner praying that

this Hon'ble Court may be pleased to enlarge the petitioner on bail in Cr.No.68/2013 of Audugodi P.S., Bangalore City and C.C.No.8041/2013 for the offence P/U/S 384 of IPC.

This Criminal Petition coming on for orders this day, the court made the following:

ORDER

Petitioner is the accused No.1 in Crime No.68/2013 for the offences punishable under Section 384 of IPC. The investigation is completed and charge sheet is filed for the offences punishable under Section 395 of IPC. This case is registered against the petitioner on the basis of the statement made by him in Crime No.71/13. The Fast Track Court, Bangalore City in Crl. Misc. No.3105/2013 vide order dated 16.7.2013 rejected the bail petition filed by the petitioner. However, it is brought to my notice that other accused in Crime No.68/13 are enlarged on bail. Now that investigation is completed and charge sheet is filed, there are no compelling circumstances warranting continuance of the petitioner in custody. Therefore, the petitioner is to be enlarged on bail.

- 2. The petition is hereby allowed. The petitioner is enlarged on bail on the following conditions:
 - i) The petitioner shall execute a personal bond for a sum of Rs.50,000/-with a solvent surety for like sum to the satisfaction of Trial Court.
 - ii) On all hearing dates the petitioner shall be present before the Trial Court.
 - iii) In no manner, the petitioner shall tamper with the prosecution witnesses.

Violation of any one of the conditions above will result in cancellation of bail order. Ordered accordingly.
