2. It is pointed out that the petitioner is due to retire on 30th June, 2013. Case made out by the petitioner is that in these circumstances, he should not be disturbed from his present place of posting in accordance with the transfer policy framed by the Government.

3. In the circumstances, it will be open to the petitioner to represent to the 2nd respondent within a period of two weeks from today. On such representation being made, his case will be disposed of by the said respondent by a speaking order, within next four weeks keeping in view the transfer policy. Till that time,

the impugned order, so far as it affects the transfer of the petitioner, shall not be implemented.

Liberty reserved to the petitioner to approach this Court again if need so arises. With these observations, the writ petition is disposed of. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
