Justice Kurian Joseph, C.J. (Oral)

The writ petition is filed with the following prayers:

“(i) That the respondents may kindly be directed to count the daily wages period of services of the petitioner towards qualifying service for pension purpose and to grant pension to the petitioner from the due date with all consequential benefits with full arrears, by issuing a writ of mandamus.

(ii) That the respondents may kindly be directed to pay interest @ 12% per annum on the arrears of pension.”

2. It is not in dispute that the matter in principle has been considered by the Punjab & Haryana High Court and the said decision has been implemented also. Therefore,

there will be a direction to the 3rd respondent/competent authority to look into the case of the petitioner also, verify his service particulars and take appropriate action in accordance with law, without discriminating the petitioner. The needful shall be done within a period of two months from the date of production of a copy of this judgment by the petitioner before the competent authority.

3. The writ petition is disposed of, so also the pending applications, if any.
