O R D E R

Petitioner is the 3rd accused in O.R.No.6/2013 of Karthikappally Excise Range for offence punishable under Section 55(a) of the Abkari Act for alleged transportation of illicit spirit in a car on 23.1.2013.

2. Accused 1 and 2 were arrested on that day and it is alleged, on the information given by them the petitioner was implicated.

3. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner is not in any way connected with the alleged incident.

4. Learned Public Prosecutor submits that there are sufficient materials to show that transportation of illicit spirit in large quantity was at the instance and instigation of the petitioner.

Having regard to the allegations made against the petitioner, the request for anticipatory bail cannot be allowed.

Petition is dismissed.
