PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

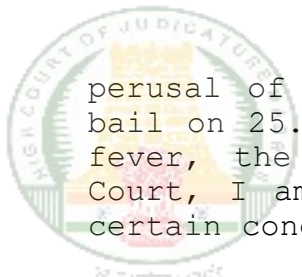
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner in Crl.O.P.(MD).No.13658 of 2013 apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Section 147, 447, 379, 201, 406, 420, 109, 120(b) of I.P.C., r/w. 3(1), 4(1) of TNPPDL Act, U/s 5 of Explosive Substance Act, 4(1), 4(1A) r/w. Section 21 to Section 21(5) of MM (D&R) Act 1957 in Crime No.201 of 2013 and the petitioners in Crl.O.P.No.13654 of 2013 apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Sections 120(b), 406, 420, 434, 447, 430, 379, 304(2) r/w 511 of I.P.C., and 3(a), 4(a) of Explosives substance Act and 3(1)(2) TNPPDL Act and 4(1), 4(1A) and 21(6) of MMDR Act in Crime No.418 of 2013 on the file of the respondent police and hence, seeks anticipatory bail.

2.The learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would submit that already the petitioner was granted anticipatory bail on 25.07.2013 in Crl.O.P.No.12045 of 2013 and because of his dengue fever, the petitioner was not able to execute the surety before the Court and apprehend arrest, he come forward with this petition.

4.Considering the rival submissions made by both sides and on



perusal of records that the petitioner was already granted anticipatory bail on 25.07.2013 in Crl.O.P.No.12045 of 2013 and because of his dengue fever, the petitioner was not able to execute the surety before the Court, I am inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

5. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Melur and on executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only) each with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further condition that the petitioner shall report before the respondent police as and when required. The petitioner shall comply with the condition stipulated under Section 438 Cr.P.C. Scrupulously.

6. The petitioner shall appear before the concerned Magistrate within a period of 15 days from the date on which the order copy made ready, failing which, the petition for anticipatory bail stands dismissed.
