PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for alleged offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 323 and 452 of I.P.C., and Section 4 of Women Harassment Act, 1998, in Crime No.62 of 2013 on the file of the respondent police and hence, they have come forward with this petition seeking anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that due to wordy quarrel between the de-facto complainant and the petitioners' family, the petitioners had trespassed and threatened the de-facto complainant.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that there was a civil dispute between the two families, the de-facto complainant preferred the complainant falsely. He would further submit that a false case has been foisted against them.

4. Heard the Learned Additional Public Prosecutor on the above submissions.

5. On consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions made, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

6. Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be enlarged on bail in the event of their arrest or on their appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the Judicial Magistrate Court, Manamadurai, Sivagangai District subject to the following conditions:-

(i) The petitioners shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) each with two sureties each for the like sum to the satisfaction of the arresting officer or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned; and

(ii) The petitioners shall appear before the respondent police daily at 11.00 a.m for a period of one week and thereafter as and when required.
