PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

In anticipation of arrest at the hands of the respondent police, the petitioner has approached this Court seeking the relief of anticipatory bail in connection with the case in Crime No.1224 of 2012, which seems to have been registered against the petitioner for the offences under Section 147 I.P.C. and Section 4 of TNPPDL Act.

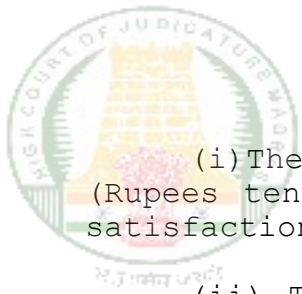
2.The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner along with others have caused damage to the Tamil Nadu State Transport Corporation bus to the extent of Rs.11,000/-.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has been implicated in this case falsely and in fact, he has nothing to do with the alleged commission offences and hence, he has urged to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

4.Heard The learned Additional Public Prosecutor on the above submissions.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of this case and also considering the nature of allegations, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

6. Accordingly the petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on anticipatory bail, in the event of his arrest or on his appearance within fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order before the Sessions Judge, District Magistrate No.V, Tirunelveli, subject to the following conditions:-



(i) The petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees ten thousand only) with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the learned Judicial Magistrate No.V, Tirunelveli; and

(ii) The petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.00 a.m. until further orders.
