PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner/accused, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offence punishable under Section 186, 423, 417, 420, 465, 468, 471, 120(b) I.P.C., in Crime No.21 of 2013 on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

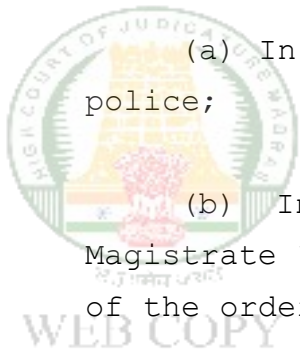
2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner and others created fabricated documents as if they are original owner of the property and the same has been registered before the Joint Registrar, Tiruchirapalli.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner's name is not found in the F.I.R. and the petitioner has been implicated based on the confession statement given by the 1st accused.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) would submit that the petitioner has no bad antecedents.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also the fact that the petitioner has no bad antecedents, I am of the view that

(a) In the event of arrest by or on appearance before the respondent police;

(b) In the event of appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Trichy within 15 days from the date of receipt of copy of the order,

(i) the petitioner shall be enlarged on bail on her executing a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties each for the like sum to their satisfaction;

(ii) the petitioner shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 p.m. for a period of two weeks and thereafter, as and when required for interrogation.
