PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners/Accused, who apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 294 (b), 393 and 506(i) I.P.C., in Crime No.183 of 2013, on the file of the respondent police, seek anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioners abused the defacto complainant with filthy language and made a life threat to him and his family members.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioners would submit that the 1st petitioner has filed O.S.No.160 of 2013 on the file of the District Munsif Court, Ramanathapuram and obtained an order of Status Quo and the civil dispute has been given criminal colour.

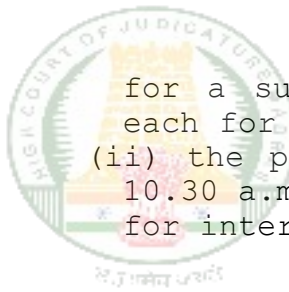
4. The learned Government Advocate (Criminal side) would submit that no injury was caused in the occurrence.

5. On consideration of the facts and circumstances of the case and the fact that no injury has been caused in the occurrence, I am of the view that the petitioners can be granted the relief prayed for and accordingly;

(a) In the event of arrest by or on appearance before the respondent police;

(b) In the event of appearance before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Ramanathapuram within 15 days from the date of receipt of copy of the order,

(i) the petitioners shall be enlarged on bail on their executing a bond



for a sum of Rs.10,000/-(Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with two sureties each for the like sum to their satisfaction;

(ii) the petitioners shall report before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m. for a period of two weeks and thereafter as and when required for interrogation.
