PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER: The Court Made the following order:-

The petitioner is arrayed as accused and he apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for alleged offences punishable under Section 454, 457 and 380 I.P.C., in Crime No.290 of 2013 on the file of the respondent police and hence, he has come forward with this petition seeking anticipatory bail.

- 2. The case of the prosecution is that the accused persons trespassed into the godown and stolen small compressor motor and Aluminium bars worth about Rs.15,000/-.
- 3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is an innocent person and he has been falsely implicated in this case. He would further submit that on the basis of the confession statement given by the co-accused, this petitioner was implicated in this case.
- 4. Learned Government Advocate (Crl. side) would submit that the coaccused stands released on anticipatory bail by this Court.
- 5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions made on either side, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.
- 6.Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail in the event of his arrest or on his appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.I, Virudhunagar subject to the following conditions:-

(Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for the like sum to the satisfaction of the arresting officer or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned; and

(ii) The petitioner shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m for a period of two weeks and thereafter as and when required for interrogation.
