PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for alleged offences punishable under Sections 420, 465, 466, 467, 468 and 471 of IPC in Crime No.87 of 2013 on the file of the respondent police and hence, they have come forward with this petition seeking anticipatory bail.

2.Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent persons and they stand falsely implicated.

3.Learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) submits that due to a civil dispute, a case has been registered against these petitioners.

4.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and considering the fact that the dispute between the petitioners and the de-facto complainant is civil in nature, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

5.Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be enlarged on bail in the event of their arrest or on their appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Special Judicial Magistrate, land Grabbing Cases, Special Court, Tirunelveli, subject to the following conditions:-

(i) The petitioners shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for the like sum to the arresting officer or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned; and



(ii) The petitioners shall appear before the respondent police every day at 10.30 a.m. for a period of one week and thereafter as and when required for interrogation.
