PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioners are arrayed as A1 to A3 and they apprehend arrest at the hands of the respondent police for alleged offences punishable under Sections 294(b), 323, 324 and 506(ii) of I.P.C., in Crime No.307 of 2013 on the file of the respondent police and hence, they have come forward with this petition seeking anticipatory bail.

2.The case of the prosecution is that there was a wordy quarrel between the parties, the petitioners attacked the de-facto complainant with hands and caused injuries.

3.Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners are innocent persons and they have been falsely implicated in this case.

4.Learned Government Advocate (Crl.side) would submit that the injured discharged from the hospital.

5.Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submissions made on either side, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioners.

6.Accordingly, the petitioners are ordered to be enlarged on bail in the event of their arrest or on their appearance, within a period of fifteen days from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, before the learned Judicial Magistrate No.II, Kovilpatti subject to the following conditions:-

(1) The petitioners shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) with two sureties each for the like sum to the satisfaction of the arresting officer or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned; and



(ii) The petitioners shall appear before the respondent police daily at 10.30 a.m for a period of two weeks and thereafter as and when required for interrogation.
